Bill of Sale

When using a bill of sale for proof of ownership to meet one of the two requirements when registering a vehicle that no longer requires a title, model year 1999 and OLDER, the following criteria MUST be met: A bill of sale of a vehicle shall contain the following information:

- (a) The date of the sale;
- (b) A description of the vehicle including:
 - (1) Make;
 - (2) Model;
 - (3) Vehicle identification number;
 - (4) Model year;
 - (5) Year of manufacture;
 - (6) Type of body; and
 - (7) Number of cylinders.
- (c) Name and address of purchaser; and
- (d) Signature and address of seller.

If the above information is not complete, we will not accept the document as proof of ownership.
