- Driveway grades are to be established that adequately protect and promote roadway drainage and permit a safe and controlled approach to the roadway/highway in all seasons of the year.
- Erosion control measures must be in place to prohibit erosion to Town ditches and onto connecting roads.
- The Town of Littleton is not responsible for natural runoff of the roadway onto the property.
- The applicant shall comply with all applicable ordinances and regulations of the municipality, State, and Federal agencies.
- Failure to adhere to the above mentioned requirements will render this permit null and void.
